# CIVIC ENGAGEMENT FOR EXPATRIATES

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The International Center is excited to introduce a program that provides civic engagement leadership training for expatriate leaders over the course of one year.

With support of a grant from the Eli Lilly and Company Foundation and through a partnership with the Indiana University Lilly Family School of Philanthropy, this new program offers participants the opportunity to develop their leadership profiles and enrich their experiences as global leaders as they learn to share their talents with the civic community in Indiana.

This engagement program, launched in February 2016, includes 9-12 months of civic leadership education, mentoring and matching, and is offered at no cost to the expatriated employee or their employer.

## THE PROGRAM

In this blend of formal and informal engagement experiences, international expatriates begin their development with a six-month formal educational program delivered by esteemed faculty of The Fund Raising School at the Indiana University Lilly Family School of Philanthropy, complemented with opportunities for mentoring and networking with non-profit leaders. The program culminates with match-making between the participants and civic community organizations, hosted by The International Center.
